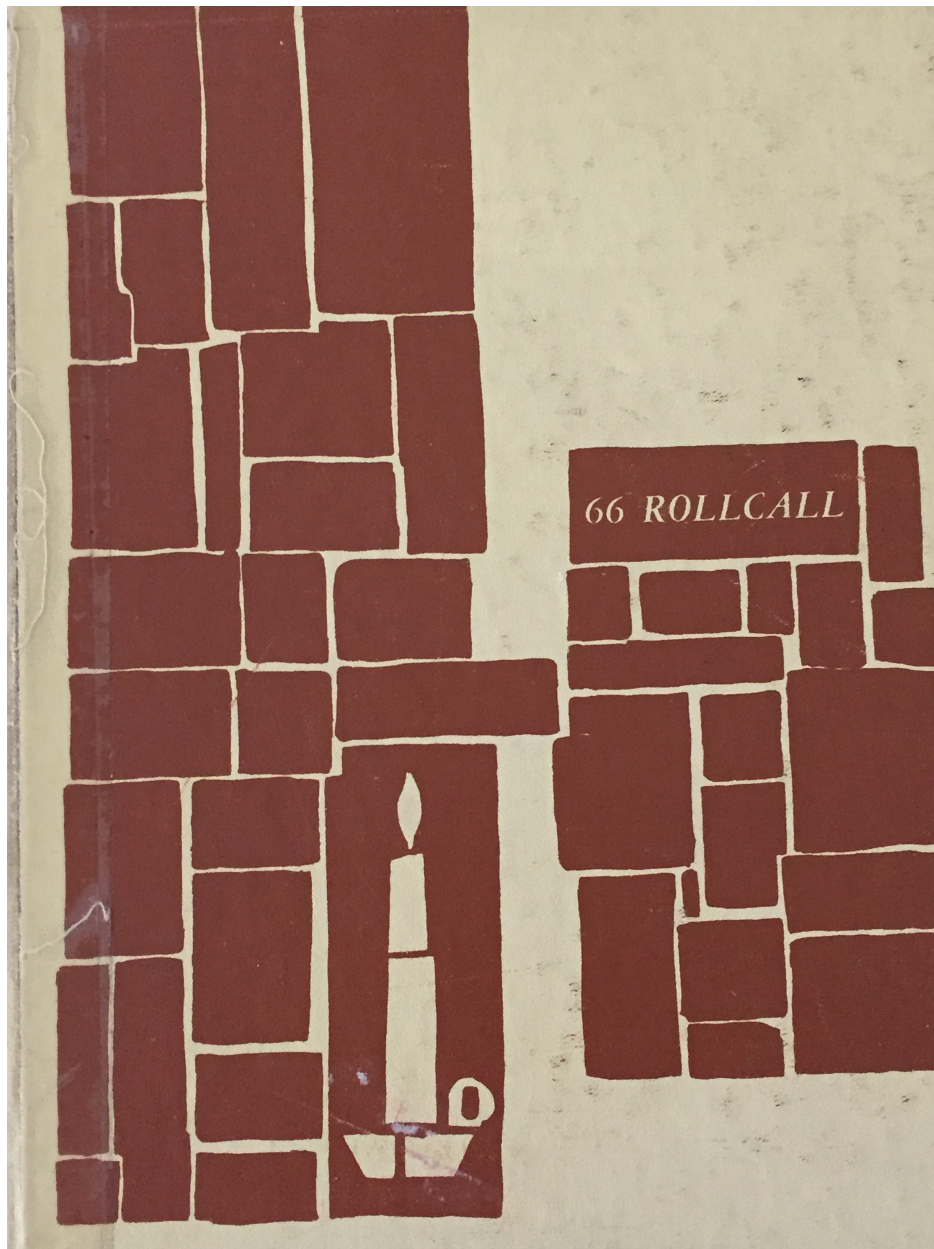


FARMINGTON HIGH SCHOOL
